Dear Chief Moffitt,

To follow up your November 19, 2019 email requesting further information for your Council, I am pleased to provide the following information:

- Kenora CACC is funded 100% by the Ministry of Health for EMS dispatching
- Zero funding is received from the Ministry of Health for fire dispatching
- There is no charge for upstaffing when a major incident occurs
- There is no cost for incident reports
- There is no charge for paging (pager checks, upstaffing, extra requests)
- Most staff are NFPA 1061 Level I and II certified (our own cost)
- CACC staff attend meetings and training throughout the district at no cost
- The dispatching cost has not increased over the last 5 years
- The dispatching cost is fixed for the next 5 years

As you can see there is a lot of service provided by Kenora CACC for the fee being charged. As well the cost has not increased in the last 5 years and will not increase for the next 5 years.
