Good Afternoon Everyone,

I am emailing you today to ask for input on a proposed event in 2021. We have been approached by a community group that wishes to host provincial men's and women's curling on the 52 Canadians Ice surface during Jan 25-31, 2021. Due to the qualifications to hold this event the group would be unable to use the curling club ice as is it stated that arena ice is required. The event would provide significant benefits to many businesses in the area and would be good for our community. We would be unable to provide ice time on the 52 Canadian's surface for our regular users from Jan 22-Feb1 to allow for the ice to be prepared and then returned to an ice hockey surface. I know that there are always tournaments on these weekends, is it possible that these tournaments be played on just the Ice For Kids surface? The Ice for Kids arena would still be available during this period and we may be able to accommodate a majority of the events we would normally hold, but I appreciate any input or concerns you may have.

I have to have a report into council by end of day Thursday so our timeline for responses is unfortunately very tight and I apologize for that. I look forward to hearing from you.
