Re: Letter dated September 16th, 2014 from Mr. D. Lee, 246 Scott Street.

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Council will recall at their meeting held September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 a request for 2 parking stalls on Scott Street was referred to the Planning and Development Executive Committee for their recommendation.

The Planning & Development Executive Committee discussed this matter at their October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014 meeting. At this meeting, the Committee heard a verbal report from the By-Law Enforcement Department, which outlined numerous concerns regarding by-laws and snow removal on Scott Street. Based on this information provided by By-Law Enforcement the committee was in agreement that a private parking stall request on Scott Street is not a request that can be approved, as Scott Street is our business district and this type of request could be detrimental to the operations of local businesses and Town Operations.

The Planning and Development Executive Committee is recommending that Council deny this request for 2 parking stalls on Scott Street.
