This report and attached Traffic By-Law Amendment I have been brought forward to the Planning & Development Executive Committee as information to ensure that the new members of Council are familiar with the background and why the amendment is brought forward to the regular Council meeting on Monday December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

Back in November the By-Law Enforcement Department had received a request from the Operations & Facilities Division to amend the Traffic Control By-Law #21/14 to provide for the closure of the Asphalt topped sidewalk on the Waterfront & Colonization Road East. The closure of this section of sidewalk along the Waterfront & Colonization Road East will ensure that Operations & Facilities can avoid the deadlines to have the snow removed, have a place to store the snow and allow ample time to have the rest of the roads cleared.

This request is part of the Operations & Facilities Division's new Winter Maintenance Policy that was recommended for approval by the Operations & Facilities Executive Committee at their regular meeting on Wednesday November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and approved by the previous Council at their regular meeting Tuesday November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018. This amendment is just a housekeeping item to keep the traffic by-law to ensure that we are in line with the new policy.
