RE: 2020 Family Day Toonie Skate

Community Services was approached by the Substance Abuse Prevention Team about the possibility of hosting a Family Day Toonie Skate on Family Day 2020. Currently the Memorial Sports Centre is scheduled to be closed for the day that day, however there is a Fort Frances Lakers Game that afternoon which would have to be staffed. We would be required to bring in additional staff to staff this event as well or extend the hours of the staff schedule to work the Fort Frances Lakers game.

The Committee has asked us to allow the skate to proceed along with allowing a donation bin being placed in the lobby beginning in January of 2020 where skates can be dropped off for underprivileged kids.

The Cost of the Ice per hour based on our 2020 proposed user fees are \$103.41 per hour.
