RE: Fort Frances Senior Centre Grant Application

In a report dated February 23, 2020 to Mayor and Council Re: Fort Frances Senior Centre Building Committee Recommendation 2020, a comprehensive review was undertaken to determine the best scenario for the Senior Centre moving forward. In that recommendation which was approved at the time, the Recreation and Culture Manager was to explore grant options available to facilitate the potential expansion of the current facility. A grant opportunity has arisen that the expansion of the Fort Frances Senior Centre qualifies for.

The expansion to the Senior Centre is not part of the 2021 approved capital budget. During the capital budget process there were no grant programs that fit this project. This grant if successful will cover 75% of eligible costs, leaving the Towns portion at \$155,375.00 for the project. If successful in the grant process the \$155,375.00 is expected to be the Towns portion and will likely be payable over 2021 and 2022 with the majority of the costs being incurred in 2022 based on the length of the project.

Recommendation

The Community Services Executive Committee recommends to Mayor and Council to authorize the submission of the 2021 Community Enhancement Program – Rural Enhancement Stream for an expansion of the Fort Frances Senior Centre.

RE: Memorial Sports Centre Grant Application

In 2020 an application was put forth for the expansion of the Memorial Sports Centre. Due to the specific grant program and the requirements that it had, a decision was made to pull our application from consideration in hopes that a grant that offered a higher level of success would come available. With the new NOHFC grants being announced, the Community Enhancement Program - Enhance your Community Stream, is a perfect fit for the proposed expansion.

The expansion to the Memorial Sports Centre is not part of the 2021 approved capital budget. During the capital budget process there were no grant programs that fit this project. This grant if successful will cover 50% of eligible costs up to \$2,000,000.00. leaving the Towns portion at \$2,675,000.00 for the project. It is expected that approximately \$500,000.00 of the cost would be spent in 2021, that \$3,200,000.00 would be spent in 2022, and that \$975,000.00 would be spent in 2023. The Towns' portion in 2021, 2022, and 2023 after the grant covers the 50% portion would be \$250,000.00, \$1,600,000.00 and \$825,000.00 respectively over those three years.

RE: Age at which the Town recognizes a Senior

At the request of the Fort Frances Senior Centre Board a review of the age at which individuals are considered a Senior at various Town of Fort Frances buildings has been reviewed. It was suggested that having different ages to be classified as a Senior in different buildings within the Town of Fort Frances was confusing.

It was found that at the Fort Frances Senior Centre that the age to use the facility is noted as 55 years or older. For patrons to be eligible to qualify for a discount on memberships, day passes, and other services at the Memorial Sports Centre the age is set at 60 years or older.

The age to be considered a Senior varies greatly and is open to interpretation. The Government of Canada benefits such as Old Age Security classifies a Senior as 65 years of age and begins those payments. The Canada Pension Plan has a payment date beginning at age 65 without penalty but allows for members to begin drawing this benefit as early as age 60 or as late as 70 which suggests that they considered retirement/senior citizens in that age range. In Private sector companies, there is also a wide interpretation of the age considered to be a Senior, with most private sector companies having an age range from 55 to 65 to qualify as a Senior.

As noted above the Town of Fort Frances currently has two different ages in two different buildings to qualify as a Senior. At 55 years of age, Citizens can use the Fort Frances Seniors Centre, at 60 Citizens qualify for the discounts available at the Memorial Sports Centre. Based on membership statistics from 2019 (Pre-Pandemic) the lost revenue from changing the age at which a discount is available at the Memorial Sports Centre would have a cost of \$3,321.14 in lost revenue.

The two divisions within the Town are very different in what they offer. The Fort Frances Senior Centre is a Social Club with no membership fees to join, where like minded individuals gather to enjoy activities, meals, and conversation together and has a minimum age to attend. The Memorial Sports Centre is a recreation facility for all ages within the Town. Many of the activities that take place at this facility are fee based and these fees help partially offset costs associated with the operation of the facility. With 60 being the age recognized as a Senior for discount purposes, the Town is in the middle of the generally recognized age of being considered a Senior.

Recommendation

The Community Services Executive Committee recommends to Mayor and Council to continue using 55 as the age for its Citizens to use the Fort Frances Senior Centre and 60 as the age in which a discount is applied to fees at the Memorial Sports Centre.

PURPOSE

The Fort Frances Children’s Complex Programs strive to conduct business according to the highest standard of honesty, integrity, respect and fairness when dealing with families. We expect that all staff, parents/caregivers, families and other visitors will also conduct themselves appropriately to meet these high standards. As adults, we are our children’s greatest role models and it is important that we promote the desired behaviors.

The intent of this Code is to clarify and give guidance on the standard of behavior expected by parent/caregiver and family members attending services in our programs and to uphold the confidence in the integrity and professionalism of the services provided by our staff. It is meant to assist in maintaining a safe and caring learning environment. Childcare Staff are governed by a similar code of conduct that outlines expectations relating specifically to their behavior.

The Corporation of the Town of Fort Frances has zero tolerance for inappropriate behaviour of staff & other patrons, including but not limited to the following:

- Threats, perceived threats, any acts of violence, bullying, harassment
- Verbal abuse, swearing, name calling or degrading responses or behaviors
- Any form of discrimination or harassment from any person associated with the Town of Fort Frances’s Childcare Programs
- Any behavior that impacts or affects staff’s ability to do their job
- Inappropriate sexual innuendos/comments whether they be verbal or written form including texts, emails and/or social media applications
- Inappropriate physical contact

BREACH OF CODE OF CONDUCT

This Policy cannot address all the possible issues which may arise within our childcare programs and services. Where an individual has any doubts as to the applicability of this policy or appropriate course of action, the matter should be taken up with the Superintendent of the Children’s Complex.

If a breach of the Code occurs, it may result in child care services being withdrawn. The decision will be made at the discretion of The Children's Complex Superintendent, in consultation with other applicable Child Care staff members and the Community Services Division Manager. Child and Family Services will be consulted if the behavior is abuse, assault or threatening.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

It is expected that as the parent/caregiver and/or family member of a child using the Town of Fort Frances Childcare Programs and Services, and when on the property of any of the childcare programs and/or services, I will adhere to the policy and following principles:

- Act courteously and respectfully at all times
- Not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Refrain from impolite, abusive or offensive behavior or language and/or violent behavior to staff or other children/families
- Be respectful of the program's environment
- Respect cultural differences of staff and other families
- Be aware of all the applicable Childcare policies, procedures and guidelines and seek clarification when necessary
- Report all concerns, issues and problems to the appropriate personnel
- Maintain a positive and proactive relationship with staff and other families
- Ensure that all individuals associated with my child are made aware of this policy and will ensure those individuals comply with such.

Purpose:

Within the Town of Fort Frances Children’s Complex programs we strive to provide a safe, caring, learning environment for children, staff and families. We believe in equality and respect diversity.

This policy sets out expectations for respectful behaviors of all children in our facilities/programs and is meant to assist in continuing to maintain a safe, caring learning environment for all who participate in our programs.

Developmental Capabilities of Children:

We understand that it is normal for children to display inappropriate behavior at times for a variety of reasons. The age and developmental capabilities of each child will always be considered when determining both expectations for behaviour and consequences of inappropriate behavior. Each situation will be considered on its own merits.

Unacceptable Behaviors:

The following behaviors behaviours by children involved in our centre are unacceptable:

- All forms of bullying (physical, verbal, emotional, social or cyber bullying), including comments, actions or visual displays that are intentional, hurtful and repetitive (Ex. Hitting, pushing, name-calling, spreading rumours, gossip in person or social networking)
- Harassment, including behaviour that degrades, demeans, humiliates or embarrasses someone that a reasonable person ought to know is unwelcome
- All forms of abuse (sexual, physical or psychological), including verbally, in writing or otherwise
- Discrimination against any person or group because of their race, colour, ancestry, nationality or place of origin, ethnic background, religion, age, sex, gender-determined characteristic, sexual orientation, marital and family status, source of income, political belief and physical or disability
- Actions that put another person at risk of harm, including violent physical acts (with or without a weapon) and threatening someone
- The inappropriate use of technology, including the internet and other technology, in keeping with the Town’s policy on the use of technology

Proactive Strategies:

We actively strive to create an environment that supports the health, safety and well-being of children by:

- Having realistic and developmentally appropriate expectations for behavior
- Setting up the environment and materials to encourage appropriate behavior and reduce potential for inappropriate behaviour
- Planning a program based on children's interests and developmental needs
- Establishing consistent yet flexible schedules and routines that help children gain trust, security and self control

We create positive environments by:

- Developing positive relationships, including making time to talk and listen
- Establishing clear, consistent, simple limits (as age appropriate)
- Stating limits in a positive way and making periodic numbers

Consequences for Inappropriate Behaviour:

We will consistently respond to inappropriate behaviour of children in our programs by:

- Reminding the child of expectations and limits (based on age appropriateness)
- Using a respectful approach to explain why a behavior is inappropriate and what behaviour is expected
- Talking only about the behaviour, not labeling the child
- Responding sympathetically and acknowledging feeling
- Establishing natural, logical consequences.

The Chart Below is a guideline for Staff:

Depending on the severity and frequency of the behaviour, we will consider further steps such as:

- Using behavioural analysis to learn what may be contributing to a child's inappropriate behaviour
- Hold an informal or formal meeting with parents/guardians/caregivers to develop an action plan to encourage appropriate behaviour in the future
- Developing a written contract with an older child that outlines specific expectations and consequence
- Accessing outside resources and/or agencies for assistance, such as:
 1. A behaviour specialist or other professionals to help staff understand and reduce a child's inappropriate behaviour
 2. Child and family services to access parenting supports
 3. The police to assist with threatening behaviour

In extreme cases, we will take such steps as:

- Suspending or withdrawing services because of a child's inappropriate behaviour
- Contacting the police and/or child and family services (CFS), if the behaviour is illegal such as abuse, assault or threatening another person

Guiding Principles for Appropriate Behaviour

Be Respectful

We are respectful of ourselves and other people. We are respectful of the ideas and feelings of others.

We are respectful of the environment, equipment and materials.

Be Responsible

We are responsible for our actions and words. We treat others as we want to be treated. When we make a mistake, we make amends rather than excuses.

Be Safe

We work and play safely to help keep ourselves and others from getting hurt.

Be Cooperative

We solve our problems by talking and listening to each other respectfully to find a solution. When we cannot solve a problem ourselves, we ask for help.

Be Supportive of Learning

We learn to the best of our abilities and support the learning of others.

*Note: If a child is sent home due to inappropriate behavior at any time throughout the day, daycare fees will be applicable for the entire day.

RE: Memorial Sports Centre Membership Statistics to Jan 2018 to Feb 2021

In the documents attached please find the monthly membership information for 2019 through February 2021 with comparison to prior year. Of importance to note is that COVID-19 has significantly impacted operations and thus memberships at the Memorial Sports Centre. The Facility was closed for part of March 2020, August 2020, December 2020, and February 2021 and all of April 2020, May 2020, June 2020, July 2020, and January 2021.

Another consideration when looking at the statistics is that more emphasis or consideration should be placed on Annual, 6-month and 3-month memberships as they hold greater value and contribute to the revenue of the facility at a higher level. With the facility being closed for part or all of 9 of the last 12 months it has caused memberships to be extended to ensure our customers were impacted as little as possible from the closure and allow them to use the facility for the time they had paid for. This extension and the previously mentioned closures have caused the number of new memberships purchased to be significantly less over the previous 12-month period and the effect of these closures and restrictions in place due to COVID-19 on new memberships will continue to linger into early summer.

Once we are through the lockdown phases of the pandemic and we are allowed to operate under at a minimum of yellow without further restrictions our memberships should stabilize.
