5.1 Finalization of Committee Terms of Reference

- The amended draft terms of reference were presented to the committee some final discussion was had on meeting times and locations and it was determined that the terms of reference were to be brought to council for approval

5.2 Location Discussion and Finalization

- Neighborhood members were in attendance and a wholesome discussion was had on the location of the park and concerns around the development in the Legion Park discussed. The Town took note of the concerns for inclusion in the design phase of the development. The property owners were generally in support of the development in Legion Park as long as their concerns would be considered through the development.

Hampton-Wood THAT the Make a Big Splash Spray Park Advisory Committee recommends that the Council of the Town of Fort Frances Designate the Legion Park for the development of a new spray park.

AND FURTHER THAT the reconstruction of Lillie Avenue from Kings Highway south to the river including the installation of signals at the intersection of Kings Highway and Lillie Avenue be completed concurrently with the splash park development at no additional cost to the residents in this neighborhood.

- 5.3 Follow up on design discussion from last meeting
 - The Town gave an update on design changes that were discussed at the last meeting. The consultant was working on a rendering with a bucket and a mermaid/fishing theme. The Town anticipated some documents in the coming days. Once more information was available the Town would pass that on to the group.
- 5.4 Update on funding opportunities
 - The Town reached out to the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund to see what programs were available. There is a funding stream available to a max of \$500,000 or 75% of eligible expenditures. The application is open now and can be submitted any time. The Town outlined their budget for the development maximizing the funding provided and broke out the fundraising goal before any design changes.

 - The Committee is hoping for a 'virtual tour' of the pad from the designer to use as 'kick off' material for the social media page. The Town is hoping for an update from the designer on that soon.

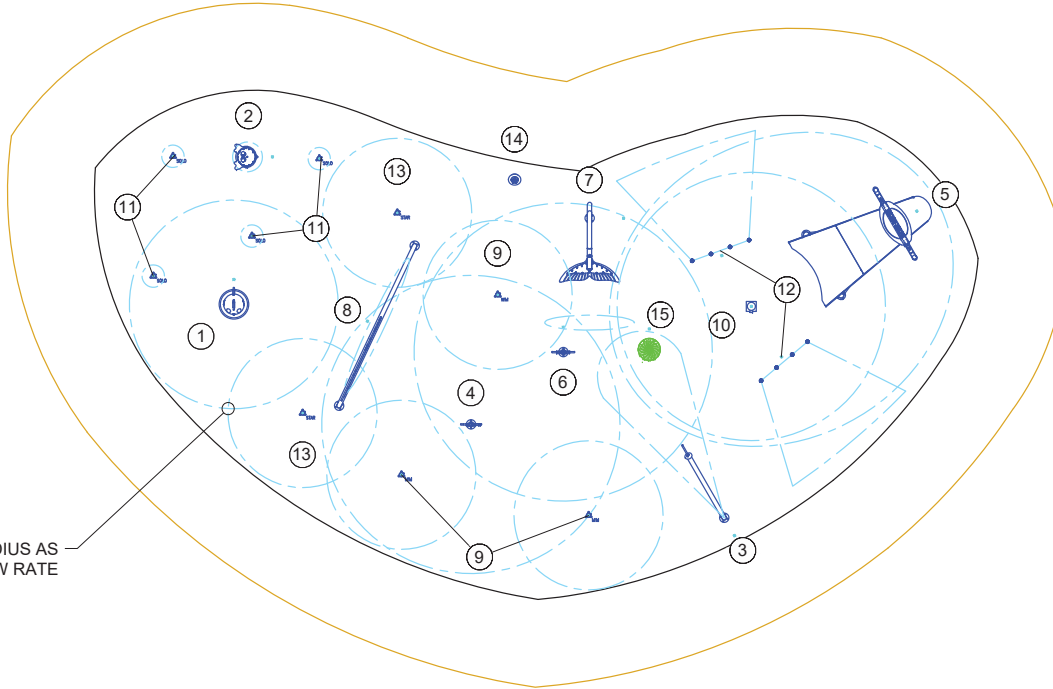

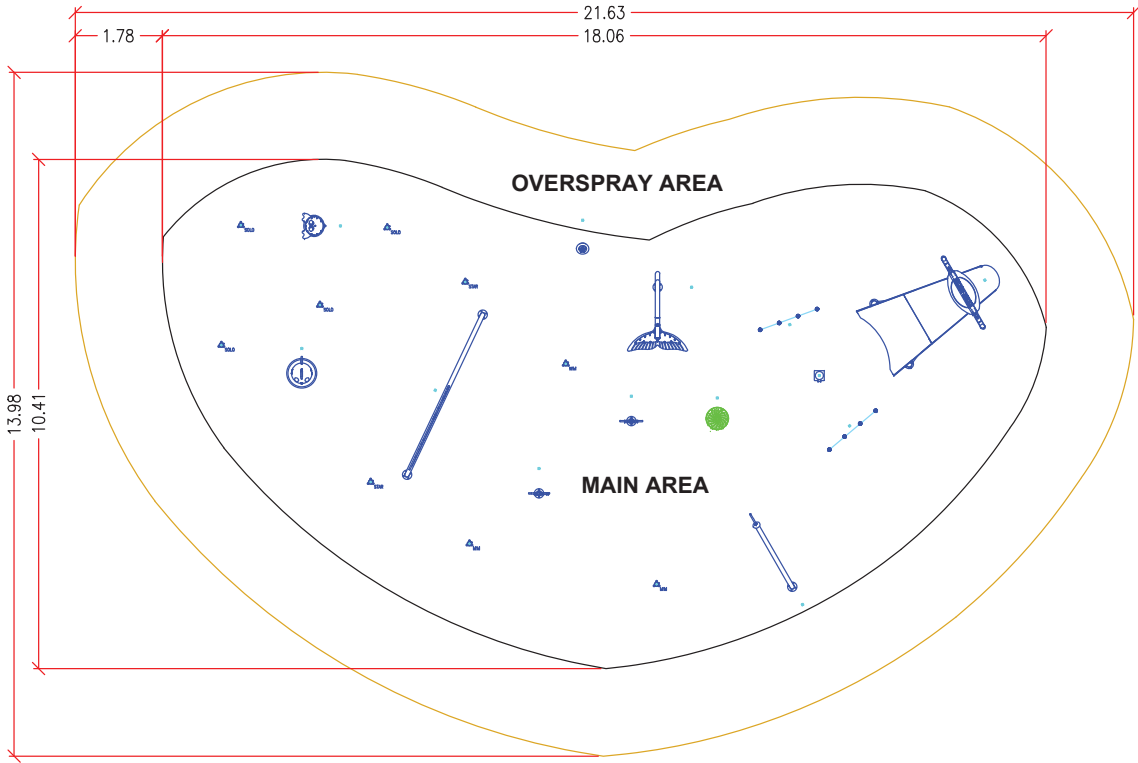

1. MAIN AQUATIC PLAY PAD AREA: 135 SQ. M.
TOTAL AREA, INCLUDING OVERSPRAY ZONE: 227 SQ. M.
 2. TO AVOID POTENTIAL DAMAGE TO SURROUNDING SOFTSCAPE AND TO KEEP PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC FROM GETTING WET, WATERPLAY RECOMMENDS A MINIMUM OVERSPRAY OF 2.44 METRES (8'). FOR AREAS WITH HIGH WINDS, A LARGER OVERSPRAY ZONE MAY BE REQUIRED.
 3. GRADE SURROUNDING OUTSIDE PERIMETER LANDSCAPE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL DRAINAGE AWAY FROM OVERSPRAY PAD.

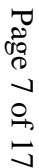

FORT FRANCES SPLASH PAD / LEGIONPARK, FORT FRANCES, ON

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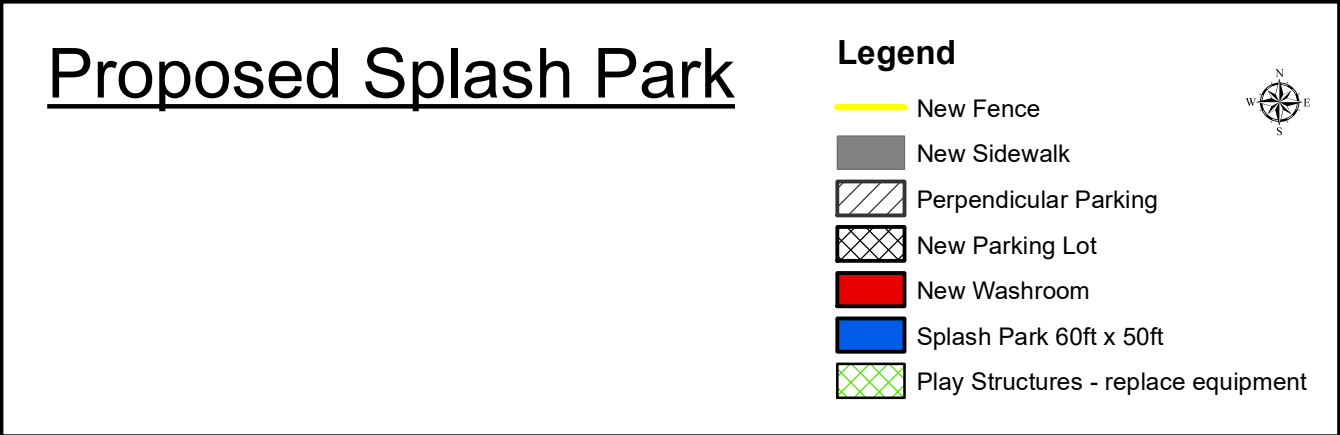
