

**TOWN OF FORT FRANCES**

**BY-LAW NO. 38/86-B**

(Being a by-law to amend By-law No. 38/86 - a by-law to regulate and control the movement of high, wide and overweight loads and special traffic.)

**WHEREAS** on July 12, 1999 Council approved a recommendation from the Planning and Development Executive Committee to provide for penalties under the moving permit by-law;

**NOW THEREFORE** Council for the Corporation of the Town of Fort Frances **HEREBY ENACTS** as follows:-

1. That Town of Fort Frances By-law No. 38/86 be amended as follows:

1) That Section 11. be repealed and subsequently re-enacted as follows:

"Every person to whom a moving permit has been issued, who contravenes any condition of this by-law, is liable to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$1,000.00 and in addition will be liable to a fine imposed in respect to any gross weight in excess of the gross weight permitted under the Highway Traffic Act, in respect to excess axle unit weight as if no special permit had been issued."

2) That new Section 12. be added as follows:



"Any person that moves any vehicle, object, or load upon any street or highway in the Town of Fort Frances prior to obtaining a moving permit shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$1,000.00."

3) That new Section 13. be added as follows:

"Every person who contravenes this By-law is guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, pay a fine as provided for in this By-law, exclusive of costs, and each such fine is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act."

This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
