whereas it is intended by the Council of Port Frances to take up the appointment of its officers at the meeting set for the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May instant, and it is deemed to appoint the Returning officer as Clerk until that date, or until such further date as his successor shall be appointed, should such successor not be appointed on the said date named

and therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Port Frances Enacts as follows

1. That Drimblegh Hester Warner as the Returning officer mentioned in the proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor be in accordance with the Statute Clerk of the Municipal Corporation until the appointment of his successor on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May instant, or until such further date as his successor may be appointed if no appointment made on said last mentioned date

2. That during such period and until his successor be appointed the said Drimblegh Hester Warner shall perform all the duties imposed on Clerks, and be clothed with the authority given Clerks by Statute

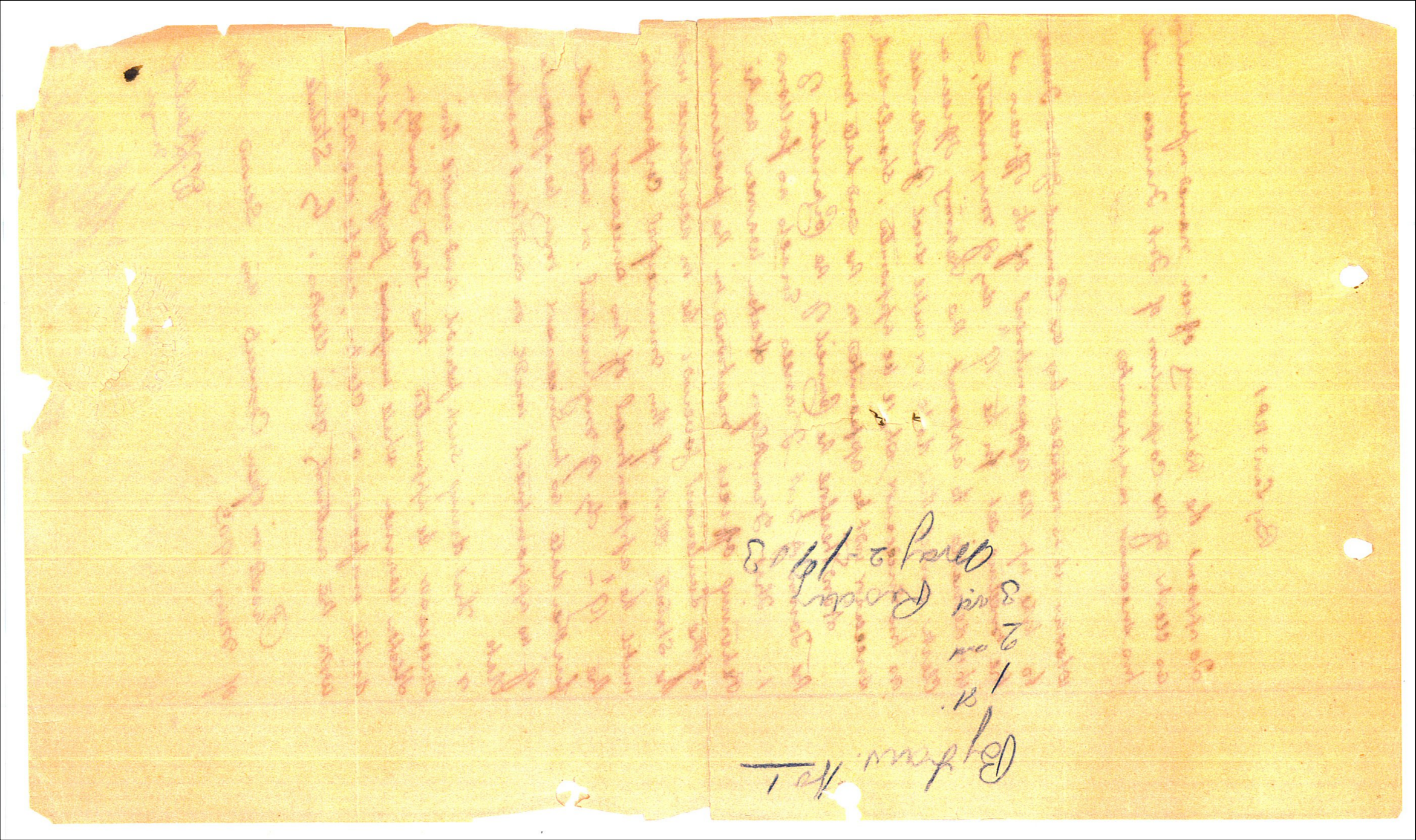

By-Laws No 3

To permit the Erection by Louis Christie of a Slaughter House on part of Lot 23 F.R. McInnis now within the Town limits and to regulate the Continuance thereof.

Whereas Louis Christie, Butcher, Fort Frances has applied to the Council to consent to the erection of a Slaughter House on part of Lot 23 F.R. McInnis within the Corporate Limits of Fort Frances; and the proposed premises have been visited and inspected by the Council and it is expedient to grant the said request, and to consent to the slaughtering of animals, the storing of hides and the other and usual branches of the trade of Butcher being carried out on said premises.

Subject to the observance of the regulations hereinafter contained

Now it is hereby enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Fort Frances,

1<sup>st</sup> That it shall be lawful for the said Louis Christie to carry on the trade of slaughtering Cattle, storing hides, Boiling <sup>the</sup> Blood, melting the Tallow and all other branches of the business as a Butcher in and upon the premises on which he has erected a Slaughter House on part of Lot 23 F.R. McInnis now within the limits of this Corporation.

2<sup>nd</sup> That inasmuch as such consent of this Council has been given upon inspection of the said premises, and upon its appearing that such provision has been made to prevent the drainage of blood or any other dangerous and deleterious matter from the said Slaughter House into the Creek flowing near said Slaughter house and into Roxy River by way of said Creek, the continuance of such permission shall be dependent the said Louis Christie continuing to take all such measures and precautions as shall prevent the escape of all such deleterious or dangerous matter from the said Slaughter House and premises into the said water course and thereby into Roxy River,

3<sup>rd</sup> That at any time that the said Slaughter House shall become, or permitted to become a nuisance; or that any rules or regulations that may be imposed by the Council or the Local Board of Health in the interests of the health of the Corporations, respecting the said Slaughter House are neglected or disobeyed, this Council may by By-Law annul the consent hereby given for the erection and continuance of the said Slaughter House and thereupon absolutely prevent the continuance thereof.
